December industry at 19,979 units January 2015 down 1% versus December 2014 January 2015 up 80% versus January 2014

Would you please find January 2015 Total Industry¹ & VAMA members only figures¹.

1) January Total Industry results in details:

- Total industry at 19,979 units of which 13,679 units were cars & 6,300 units were trucks.
- Cars were up 3% vs. last month and Trucks were down 10%.
- CKD volume was 13,487 units, up 0.3% vs. last month and CBU was 6,492 units, down 4% vs last month.




