1) February Total Industry results in details:

- Total industry at 12,329 units of which 8,899 units were Passenger Cars & 3,430 units were Commercial Vehicles.
- Passenger Cars were down 35% vs. last month and Commercial Vehicles were down 46%.
- CKD volume was 7,914 units, down 41% vs. last month and CBU was 4,415 units, down 32% vs last month.




